REGIONAL ANAESTHESIA SPECIAL INTEREST GROUP CONFERENCE

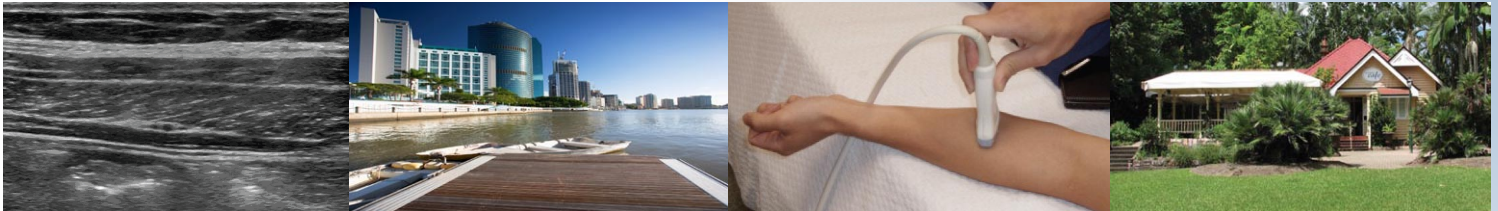

ABSTRACT INSTRUCTIONS

- All abstracts must be submitted in MS Word.
- Photographs/images should be sent in Jpeg or Tiff format with reference made to the position of the figure in the abstract text (e.g. "positioned around the curve of the abdominal wall" [Figure 1]).
- Include your title, full name, position and hospital/organisation (e.g. Dr Don Brown, Staff Specialist, The Mater Hospital, Sydney).
- Authors should obtain written permission to reproduce written material and acknowledge the source(s).

POSTER PRESENTATIONS

- All poster presenters will have their abstract published in the ASURA Abstract Book.
- Selected presenters will be notified by 31 July 2009 if they have been accepted to present a 10 minute poster presentation during the meeting. This includes a five minute summary followed by five minutes of questions and discussion from observers and the adjudicators.
- Posters will be displayed throughout the meeting. Presenters will be expected to erect their posters by 7:30am sharp on Saturday 21 November.
- Posters are to be no more than A1.
- A prize and certificate will be awarded for the best poster presented at the meeting.
